- Mrs White is back as the prep teacher Wed/Thurs/Fri working with K-3
- Before School Safety
 - Start time is 7:59 with 15 minutes of supervision before class
 - Students are not allowed to play on the playground before school to keep the mixing of cohorts to a minimum
 - Students are to go to their class line ups and wait there
 - Not worried about late students at this point and would like students to arrive as close to the bell as possible
 - Staff will be outside in the am to enforce this
- Still having trouble with Hotmail/gmail so please ask a friend to forward any emails if possible
- Classes are set and no cohorts were switched around
- Two different recess and lunch breaks
 - Students are then separated within the playground area
- o Kids outside for 15-20 minute spurts right now due to the smoke
- Social/Emotional Health
 - Building relationships and making sure the kids feel safe is a first priority right now
 - Report cards may look a little different in November due to this but with how traumatic some things have been for some kids the social/emotional piece comes first
- As the air clears most days will be outside days so please dress for the weather, the kids will be outside even in the rain unless it's raining sideways
- Fire Drill scheduled for Friday (without the bell)
 - Students will be spread out further outside so cohorts do not mix
- Will have a lock down drill and earthquake drills coming up
- New Gym Upgrades
 - The sound system has been installed
 - The Stage is now accessible
- o Orange Shirt Day Oct 30th
- o Terry Fox Run
 - Being planned
 - Will be separating cohorts
 - If parents would like to participate to watch check points
 - Must be physically distanced and wear a mask if possible
 - Date Monday October 5th
 - Will still be fundraising with a coin drive
- Nut and Kiwi Allergies at the school currently
 - Those classrooms will be made aware
- Bowls of Hope Soup Program
 - Will continue as they are a known food source following safety protocols
- Students bringing books
 - Students are allowed to bring books from home

- Library days follow their cohorts so only those students are in the library on their library day
- Paper is a very low source of transmission if at all
