Drop off and Dismissal Procedures

Parent parking is available school parking lot (do not park in the Staff Stalls), along the road heading south on South Sumas and the church parking lot as well. Please be aware that as a bussing school,



busses need to be able to access the front pull-in lane to safely drop our students off. Cones will be placed on either side of this area to help with this. Thank you in advance for your patience regarding our parking areas. Please enter and exit the drop off zone appropriately. Please have your children arrive at school no earlier than 7:44, as we are unable to provide adequate supervision before that time. Again, we will be suggesting a "Drop Off and Go" at the beginning of the day as well as a "Pick Up and Go" at the end of the day. This being suggested, students will be able to access the playground before and after school!

Parent Volunteers and Visitor Information

We kindly ask that all parents and visitors enter through the main front doors when coming to the school. Please do not enter through any side doors or classroom doors.

All visitors MUST be wearing a mask before entering the school, sign-in at the office, and sanitize hands. All volunteers will be required to follow the <u>Health and Safety</u> Protocols set out by the Ministry of Education.

We do require our parent volunteers to have a Criminal Record Check completed. Please contact the office to see if your Record Check has not expired or to get a new form.

Lunch Drop Off, Early Pick Up or Messages

If you need to drop off lunch or need to get a message to your child, please leave them at the office and Mrs. Holmes will gladly bring them to your child. We are hoping to keep the areas outside of the classrooms and the office quiet to ensure a peaceful working environment.
