We truly appreciate your cooperation and understanding in keeping the area safe for all.



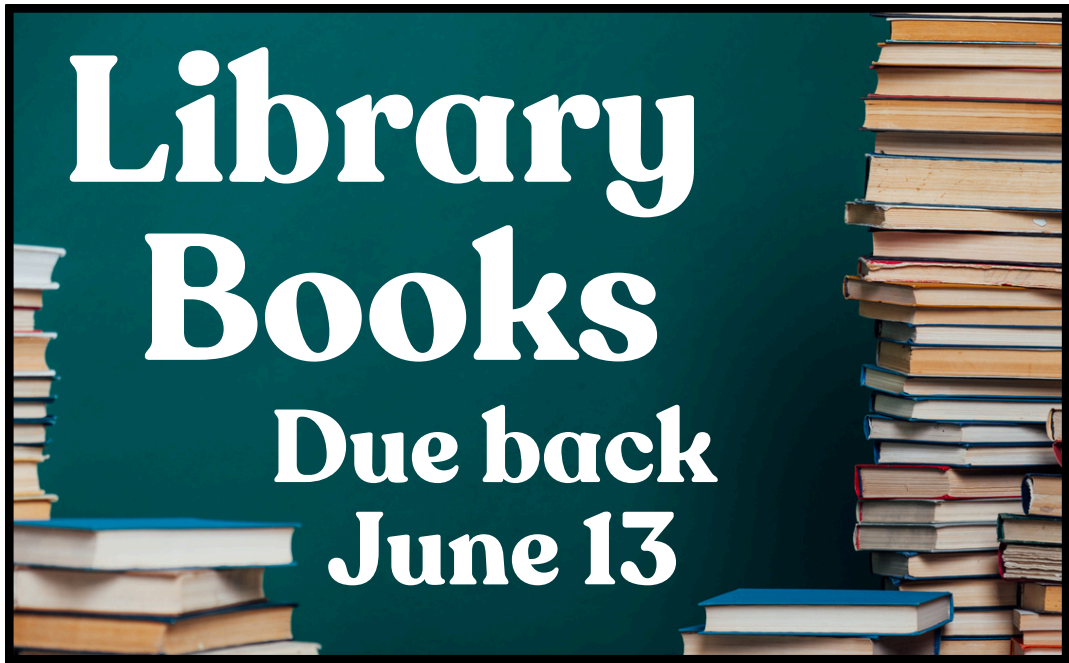
