g. Community School (GESCC)

- -Current programming: Free play and crafts, community: karate and CORE class
- -coming up in October: dance (gr 3-5) stations (K-2), art
- -home alone and babysitting courses (age 10+ on Saturdays)

h. Principal – Brad Driscoll

- -we are sitting at 163 students enrolled
- -3 staff are currently on leave (Durflinger is expected to return mid-October, Deagle end of October, Arsenault beginning of December)
- -kids are settling in nicely
- -the school district did a big refresh of their strategic plan: They took information from last year, getting input from schools, staff, parents, students, etc
- -in the center is the student, surrounded by other priorities (transitions, well-being, numeracy, literacy), then how students are supported, then district values, then indigenous medicine wheel (seasons, cycles, etc)
- -now we need to align our school goals to the strategic plan
- -looking at the 4 priority categories: how aligned are we with the strategic plan? Where is our learning and our growth? How can we make changes/improvements?
- -this will be the topic of October staff meetings (Brad will update us later this year)
- -Code of Conduct: We will have a focus committee to go through and revise it email Brad if you would like to be a part of this!
- -monthly virtues still being done (Grandfather teachings)
- -House teams will be back Eagle 10s and 25s are already being handed out winning house team gets a trophy at the monthly assemblies (building school community)
- -Whole School Events afternoon games, Cops for Cancer
- -Cross country is on right now (grades 3-5): led by Mrs Ferguson, Mrs B and Ms McKinley
- -Soccer starting in October (grade 4-5): led by Mr Hoeppner
